The instructions given below should be strictly followed by the candidates:

- i. Candidates having near or far sightedness should bring latest prescription from any **Government Eye Specialist** with suitable glasses worn at the time of Medical Examination.
- ii. Candidates should bring their **original CNIC** alongwith **one photocopy**.
- iii. Two latest passport size **Photographs**.
- iv. To facilitate medical examination, candidates are advised to put on **underwear**.
- v. **Fee for CMB Examination, @ Rs. 1400/-** in cash will be charged from each candidate at the spot.
- vi. **Rs.100/-** is required to be deposited in Government Treasury/State Bank of Pakistan under Head of Account **"C-02839-HEALTH Fee for Medical Examination"** on behalf of the Directorate of Central Health Establishment, Islamabad and **original copy of Treasury Challan may be handed over to the Medical Board at the time of your Medical Examination.**
- vii. **No TA/DA** for attendance at CMB examination is permissible under the Rules.

A). Deferred Candidates:-

Candidates are advised to fulfill medical requirement (Reduced weight, Lab. Tests/X-Ray etc) as conveyed to them individually at the time of their Medical Examination. Similarly, candidates deferred on account of eye sight problem/ or candidates wearing glasses should get themselves examined by any **Federal/Provincial Government eye specialist and bring Fresh prescription alongwith glasses.**

B). Absent Candidates:- (appearing first time before Central Medical Board)

- i. Candidates will have to submit their **Chest X-Ray alongwith report** and fresh reports for **Serum Lipid Profile (F), HbsAg, Anti HCV, Blood CP, LFT's ESR and Urine-RE** from any Government Hospital.
 - ii. Pregnant women should get **Ultrasound abdomen instead of CXR.**
 - iii. A latest prescription from any Government eye specialist with suitable glasses worn at the time of Medical Examination.
2. In terms of Rule 9 (iv) of CE-2018, if any candidate remains absent twice in his/her medical examination, his/her candidature will automatically stand rejected and no appeal in this regard will be entertained. However, his/her chance will be considered as consumed.
