






Ambassador /High Commissioner (R) Muhammad Nafees Zakaria, Member FPSC resigned from the office of the Member FPSC on 31.10.2022.

Meeting of Senior Members of FPSC with Chief Minister Gilgit Baltistan:

A Meeting was held on 16th November, 2022 in the Office of Chief Minister Gilgit-Baltistan. Senior Members of FPSC, Captain(R) Shahid Ashraf Tarar, Mr, Akbar Hussain Durrani (TI) and Mr. Nasir Hussain Shah, Regional Head FPSC Gilgit Baltistan called on the Chief Minister Gilgit-Baltistan. The meeting was chaired by the Chief Minister, Gilgit-Baltistan and Chief Secretary Gilgit-Baltistan, Secretary Home GB, Senior Member Board of Revenue GB, Commissioner Gilgit and Deputy Commissioner Gilgit also attended the meeting. After detailed deliberations, the chair issued directives relating to land allotment to FPSC for construction of office accommodation at Gilgit and Skardu as well for allotment of government building for use by FPSC regional office till construction of its own building.

Progress Review regarding CBT Project:

Project review meetings were held on 15.11.2022 and 05.12.2022, presided by DG(Research) where in basic features of sub-modules of Management including (Human Resource Management System, Transport Management System, Control Room and Finance Management System) developed under the project were presented before the chair for approval and integration into the online recruitment system software. Software Requirement Specifications (SRS) developed pertaining to GR/CSS/Log/HR and Official website of FPSC were also reviewed.

i. Latest position of CSS Competitive Examinations: MPT for CSS-2023 was held on 2.10.2022. Advertisement for CE-2023 was issued on 30.10.2022. Online applications were received during the period from 1.11.2022 to 14.11.2022, followed by submission of hard copy of online form along with all documents by 24.11.2022. - **a.** Litigation: Under Section 7(3) (d) of the FPSC Ordinance 1977, candidates who are not satisfied with the decision of the Commission, are provided an opportunity to file Representations for redressal of their grievances. They are heard in person by the Commission. If still feel aggrieved, they can approach High Courts for adjudication. Details of litigation, by or against the Commission in various Courts of Law and latest position indicate that there were 537 Cases out of which 38 were decided during quarter October-December, 2022.
- **b. Update on Prime Minister's Delivery Unit (PMDU):** During the period October-December/2022, 183 complaints in all were received by the FPSC. All of these were responded well in time and resolved.
