Litigation

Under Section 7(3) (d) of the FPSC Ordinance 1977, aggrieved candidates are provided with an opportunity to file Representations/Review Petitions for redressal of their grievances, after which they can approach High Courts for adjudication if desired. Details of litigation, by or against the Commission in various Courts of Law indicate that out of 552 Cases, 28 were decided during quarter January-March, 2024.
