



iii. Special CSS Competitive Examination: This scheme of examination was approved by federal government vide SRO.No.1906 (I)/2022 to provide a special opportunity, encouraging candidates from under privileged areas and segments of society. Federal Cabinet also approved enhancement of upper age limit upto 35 years for Special CSS Examination. Accordingly, 54300 applications were received for conduct of MPT screening test to be held on 21<sup>st</sup> May 2023.



**a.** Litigation: Under Section 7(3) (d) of the FPSC Ordinance 1977, candidates who are not satisfied with the decision of the Commission, are provided with an opportunity to file Representations for redressal of their grievances. They are heard in person by the Commission by arranging Personal Hearings/ Review Petitions. If still feel aggrieved, they can approach High Courts for adjudication. Details of litigation, by or against the Commission in various Courts of Law and latest position indicate that there were 578 Cases out of which 27 were decided during quarter January-March, 2023.

**b. Update on Prime Minister's Delivery Unit (PMDU):** During the period January-March/2023, 246 complaints in all were received by the FPSC. All of these were responded well in time and resolved.
